For RN and LPN New Graduates!

We will provide your organization with:

- Access to the modules for your site coordinators, preceptors, and nurse residents. (If you would like to use the modules for other staff, please let us know.)
- A detailed plan for program topics.
- Incentives and resources to support your organization and staff.

Organization Expectations:

- Identify a site coordinator for us. (Preferably your nurse educator)
- You hire new graduate RNs or LPNs.
- Provide the time required for the nurse residents and preceptors to complete the modules and meet virtually with Dr. Hassler monthly.



12-month Program Structure:

- Preceptors will meet with Dr. Hassler for 1 hour at the beginning of the cohort, and they will have 4 modules to complete and 6 modules that will provide them with leadership training.
- Site coordinators will meet with Dr. Hassler for 1.5 hours at the beginning of the program to understand their responsibilities.
- Nurse residents will meet with Dr. Hassler for 2 hours at the beginning of the program to understand their expectations and for instruction on how to navigate the Learning Management System.
- 1st week of every month, site coordinators will schedule 1-2 hours (depending on the topic) to complete modules on site at their organization.
- 2nd or 3rd week of every month, (11 am on Wednesdays) site coordinators will schedule time and space for nurse residents to join virtually with faculty to discuss topics and how they are progressing as new graduates.
- Each new nurse resident will be required to work on a QAPI project.
