About The Primary Care APN Workforce Dashboard

The primary care APN workforce dashboard is an interactive Tableau dashboard that provides New Jersey's primary care APN workforce data visualization to educators, nurse researchers, policymakers, and other stakeholders. **Primary Care APNs** are defined as Nurse Practitioner (NPs) and Certified Nurse Midwives (CNMs) whose employment setting is not a hospital. A total of 8,616 primary care APNs are included in this dashboard.

How to use the dashboard:

- 1. Click on any categories in any sections of your interest
- 2. Continue clicking on any categories in any sections of your interest to explore the data
- 3. (Optional) Download the result as an image, PDF, or PowerPoint

Source of data:

The data was acquired from 2023 and 2024 New Jersey Board of Nursing (NJBON) Nursys® license renewal surveys. Nurses renew their licenses every two years, so the dashboard shows the data based on the survey period 2023-2024, not individual year.

Number of Responses:

2023 - 2024 Survey Period

APN: 15,617 APNs responded out of 16,317 active licensed APNs and 3,034 inactive APNs in New Jersey.

Primary Care APN: 8,616 APNs were identified as primary care APNs by NJCCN.

Downloads:

Visualizations from the interactive Tableau dashboards can be downloaded as an image, PDF, or PowerPoint using the download feature in the bottom right corner of the dashboard.

Additional Notes:

- 1. The data does not represent the entire primary care APN workforce in New Jersey since the survey is not required.
- 2. The 'Percent' is based on the total number of respondents to the total number of survey respondents, not the total number of nurses in the workforce.
- 3. The sum of the 'Percent' in the County of Employment section is not equal to 100 because many respondents did not answer their county of employment.
